Background and Purpose: Countryside Disciples Women have served God faithfully since the beginning of this congregation in 1940. As women of faith, they provided consistent nurture for their families, the congregation, their networks of influence and involvement in the community, and through their vocations. Many of the current generation of adult women at Countryside were recipients of that nurture and leadership training.

Honoring the values we share with our foremothers, we established a scholarship fund. As funds are raised, they will be disbursed accordingly – not maintained as an endowment fund. The intent of this scholarship is to help individuals further their education after high school with an emphasis toward their willingness to serve God through their faith, family and vocation. A scholarship committee will review and select recipients. Recipients are urged to communicate with the Countryside Disciples Women once the semester/quarter/program has begun to let donors know how the recipient is doing and, if appropriate, how or what the recipient has discovered about God's intention for their life.

Criteria for Consideration Include:

- Female recipients are preferred, but appropriate male recipients are not ruled out.
- An existing relationship with Countryside Christian Church (DOC): either a member, relative of member, friend of member, or resident of the nearby community and have participated in church activities
- A desire to further her/his education and an ability to demonstrate her/his care and concern for faith and community
- Successful completion of high school or GED, providing a copy of diploma or certificate
- Acceptance at an institution of higher education, whether seeking a degree or working on continuing education required for vocational training or specialization
- Applications are open to full-time or part-time learners.
